EPA Region 3	MAB Environmental Services, Inc., Matthew Brozena and others	Clean Water Act – Alleged knowingly violating permit conditions, tampering with required monitoring devices and methods, false reporting and conspiracy
EPA Region 3	Chem-Solve, Inc.	Resource Conservation and Recovery Act – Allegedly illegal storage and transportation of hazardous waste

EPA Region 6	Cherry Way, Inc., Elaine Chiu	Clean Air Act – Allegedly knowingly failed to notify and report demolition of river boat
EPA Region 7	JACAM Manufacturing, LLC	Resource Conservation and Recovery Act – Allegedly unlawfully disposed of hazardous waste into salt waters disposal well
