## Air Enforcement: Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality and Tupelo, Mississippi Facility Enter Into Agreed Order Addressing Alleged Violations

The Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality ("Mississippi") and Innocor Foam Technologies – ACP, Inc. ("IFT") entered into a January 20<sup>th</sup> Agreed Order ("AO") addressing alleged violations of a Clean Air Act Title V air permit. See Order No. 6612 16.

The AO states that IFT operates a facility in Tupelo, Mississippi.

IFT's Tupelo, Mississippi facility holds a Title V Operating Permit. It is alleged that on March 11, 2015 IFT was contacted by Mississippi and notified that the company had failed:

... to submit a process change notification for approval prior to installing and running the new fiber line which is a violation of the facility's Title V Operating Permit No. 1540-00046.

IFT agrees to a civil penalty of \$37,000.
