# Beaver Lake Watershed Symposium: Beaver Watershed Alliance Schedules Source Water Stewardship Program – Lowell, Arkansas/September 29th

The Beaver Watershed Alliance (“BWA”) announced the scheduling of a program titled *Source Water Stewardship* (“*Program*”) that will be held as part of the Beaver Lake Water Symposium.

The *Program* will be held on September 29<sup>th</sup> in Lowell, Arkansas.

BWA states that the *Program* is designed to present participants with information regarding emerging issues such as:

- Harmful algal blooms in Beaver Lake
- Long term water quality trends in the White River

BWA indicates the discussion will also address “management considerations and actions” which include:

- The United States Army Corps of Engineering Master Plan and Shoreline Management Plan
- Open Space Planning for Benton and Washington County
- Regional Sourcewater Protection Funding
- The LandWise Initiative
- Regional Conservation Partnership Program – West Fork White River Watershed Restoration Initiative

The *Program* is scheduled from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and will be held at the Northwest Arkansas Realty Board Facility located at 314 N. Goad Springs Road.
