- U.S. D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals Decision vacating and remanding the Affordable Clean Energy Rule

- Discussion of grid considerations as related to fuel type and mix

- Clean Power Plan ("CPP") (Climate Rule That Never Fully Was)
- Proposed first-ever national standards to address carbon pollution from electric-generating units
- Relied on generation shifting to lower-emitting sources of electricity through the grid system such as natural gas and renewables
- U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") stated CPP would reduce carbon pollution from power sector by 32 percent below 2005 levels
- Opponents claimed the rule exceeded the scope of EPA's Clean Air Act authority
- Impact on Arkansas
- Review of litigation challenging/supporting CPP
- Affordable Clean Energy Rule ("ACE")
- Repealed the CPP
- Power plant efficiency-based guidelines
- Unit-level compliance

- EPA asserted that the CPP was impermissibly based on implementation rather than application of BSER
- ACE designated facilities
- Arkansas subunit identification (seven units at five power plants)
- Requirements for state plans
- Compliance pathways
- Litigation opposing/supporting ACE (District of Columbia Circuit Court of Appeals Vacates ACE)
- President Biden's EPA
