...restoration of Muskegon Lake and its associated wetlands in Michigan, covering water quality, ecosystem restoration, and socioeconomics.

The project is described as involving wetland restorations reducing phosphorus concentrations from over 0.8 ppm to 0.03 ppm. Further, the restoration efforts are described as showing a 5.8:1 return on investment or 1 billion in increased shoreline development.
