- Reliability concerns.

- Workforce needs.
- Equity
- Increasing physical security and Cybersecurity threats.

Such policies are stated to:

- Shape energy markets.
- Support energy system security.
- Reduce costs and emissions.
- Accelerate innovation.
- Spur economic development.

The Recommendations include:

- 1. Support State-Federal Energy Policy and Program Coordination.
- 2. Advance Federal Permitting Reform.
- 3. Support Electric System Reliability and Security.

- 4. Modernize the Electric Grid.
- 5. Incentivize State Energy Office—Private Sector Energy Partnerships.
- 6. Create Opportunities for Underserved Communities.
