Mr. Mitchell has decades of experience working with landowners and forest management in NW Arkansas. He will be leading a forest walk and talk where participants can ask questions and see real-world examples of when and where forestry practices are needed and the logistics of getting practices implemented.

If you live in the War Eagle watershed, special funding is available to you through the Regional Conservation Partnership Program. We will help you learn about this program and assist with the paperwork and the signup process.
