Thank you for your interest in the Arkansas Energy Code update. As you may be aware, the Arkansas Department of Energy & Environment, Energy Office (AEO) developed a new version of the Arkansas Energy Code based on the 2018 IECC with state amendments. The purpose of this letter is to keep you updated on the new energy code development and approval process, as well as to provide relevant educational opportunities and resources.

Approval of the new energy code is targeted for Q1 2023 with an anticipated effective date of January 1st, 2024. AEO has been working with you to plan education and training opportunities to support the implementation of the new Arkansas Energy Code.
