27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

29 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-3-603(3)(B), concerning the businesses
30 and industries included in the definition of "eligible applicant" under the
31 Arkansas Business and Technology Accelerator Act, is amended to add an
32 additional subdivision to read as follows:

33 (viii) A business primarily engaged in operating
34 combustors and incinerators for the disposal of nonhazardous solid waste, as
35 classified in code 562213 of the 2022 North American Industry Classification
36 System.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2703(8), concerning the businesses and industries included in the definition of "eligible businesses" under the Consolidated Incentive Act of 2003, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(L) Businesses primarily engaged in operating combustors and incinerators for the disposal of nonhazardous solid waste, as classified in code 562213 of the 2022 North American Industry Classification System.
