







On June 4, 2018, Charles Moulton, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), issued Order No. 1 (Recommended Decision) in Docket No. 18-001-MISC, which is a case styled: In the Matter of C&H Hog Farms, Inc.


Order No. 1 finds that there are no genuine material facts in dispute and, based on the law;

1. Denies C&H's Motion for Summary Judgment on its Request for Declaratory Order; and
2. Finds that there are no genuine material facts in dispute and, based on the law grants Interveners' Motion for Summary Judgment on C&H's Request for Declaratory Order.
